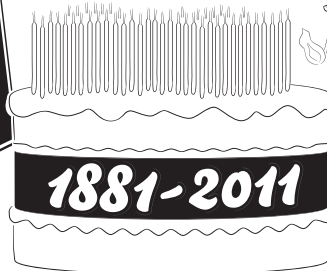

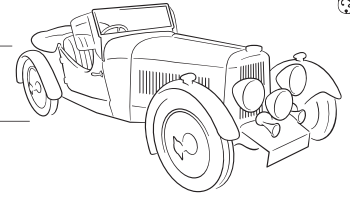

◆ SITE INFORMATION ◆



The convention will be held at The Dearborn Inn, 20301 Oakwood Blvd, Dearborn, MI 48124.

There will be transportation to specific other events in downtown Detroit.

◆ HOTEL INFORMATION ◆

Reservations should be made directly with the hotel by phoning Marriott reservations at 1-800-228-9290.

Mention the name of the hotel and the event, “**Wodehouse Society Conference 2011.**” Standard room rate is \$115.00 a night plus tax (approximately 14% as of this writing). Deluxe rooms are available, but you are on your own as regards price. Because of the exigencies of contract law, rooms are limited, so book early.

No reservations will be taken before October 15, 2010, or after September 22, 2011.

◆ SCHEDULE of EVENTS ◆

THURSDAY: A tour of the historic River Rouge Ford plant begins at Greenfield Village at 2 p.m. Those wishing to attend this function *must* be registered by June 16, 2011. Those who wish to join the group *may* be able to do so for an additional dollar.

THURSDAY NIGHT: Dinner on your own, but a group will be going to Miller’s Bar, a “greasy spoon” and Dearborn tradition, featured on the Food Network and often voted “best burger in metro Detroit.” Dinner at the hotel is also available for the less adventurous. Traditional informal meeting in the bar afterwards.

FRIDAY: On your own. Transportation to Greenfield Village/ Henry Ford Museum (“The Henry Ford”) available for those not up for the half-mile walk. A guided bus tour of Detroit from 9:30 a.m. till 2 p.m. includes a drive around Belle Isle (see *The Adventures of Sally*), lunch at Lafayette Coney Island‡ (another famous Detroit greasy spoon featured on the Food Network), and many other fascinating and historic Detroit sites, finishing up at John King books. Tour returns to hotel just in time for the “Wodehouse Cricket Experience” in the afternoon (wind and weather permitting).

FRIDAY EVENING: Reception (cash bar and light *hors d’œuvres*) followed by transportation to the MGM Grand Hotel & Casino with dinner on your own at any of six restaurants. Browsing, sluicing and gambling until midnight (or after, if you like, but the last bus will leave at midnight).

SATURDAY: Riveting talks all day. Transportation continues to The Henry Ford for those who are not riveted. BBQ lunch at the lunch break, or dine on your own at the hotel (there is no restaurant within walking distance). A fun, instructional cooking demonstration with the Inn’s chef will be held after lunch for lecture non-attendees, but we must have 20 or more reservations by Sept. 4 or class will be cancelled (any who paid ahead will be reimbursed at registration).

SATURDAY NIGHT: Plum’s 130th Birthday Party. Cocktails and Banquet in the exquisite Alexandria Ballroom. The usual mélange of browsing, sluicing, entertainment, costumes, auctions, awards ceremony and the like.

SUNDAY: Brunch, entertainment and tearful farewells.
